NAMING THE ALLEN BRIDGES TRAINING ACADEMY**

**WHEREAS**, prior to becoming the Hays County Sheriff, Allen Bridges honorably served for 33 years in law enforcement, in Austin, Texas and in Hays County, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, Allen Bridges continued to serve his community up until the very day he passed from this world, on December 6, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, Hays County still recalls the legacy of leadership, dedication and giving that Allen Bridges left to his County and to his colleagues; and

**WHEREAS**, naming the newly-built training center, located at the Sheriff's Office on Uhland Road in San Marcos, Texas after Allen Bridges is a fitting way to extend his legacy of professionalism and to provide cadets-and-officers-in-training a role model for excellence;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HAYS COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, THAT:**

The Sheriff's Office Training Academy, once substantially complete, shall be named the Allen Bridges Training Academy, to honor the memory and legacy of the late Sheriff Allen Bridges.
